Moorpark	27 year old-Male Autism	Sundays 7am-10am	Individual is currently training with the Thousand Oaks Pacers in running. Family is looking for a caregiver who loves to run and will attend these trainings with him. Caregiver needs to be active and be able to run/keep up with him.
Newbury Park	10 year old-Male Intellectual Disability	Tuesdays 2:15/2:30pm-5:15pm Possible Friday evenings (as needed/flexible) for 3 to 4 hours	Parent would like caregiver to pick up son from school and then take him home to provide respite. School is about 6 miles from the family home.
Newbury Park	24 year old-Male Autism/Visually impaired	Tuesdays 3pm-6pm Sundays 1pm-5pm	Tuesdays - the family would like the caregiver to take him to the gym and work out with him and then take him home to provide respite. Sundays - the family is requesting the caregiver to pick him up from home, take him to the gym and then take him back home. The gym is Fitness 19 in Newbury Park. Family lives 10 minutes from the gym. Caregiver who can transport preferred.
Newbury Park	30 year old-Male Autism/PICA	Tuesdays & Thursdays 1pm-3pm	Parent would like caregiver to take the individual to the gym. Gym is 24-Hour Fitness in Thousand Oaks (no membership needed). Female caregiver preferred by family.
Simi Valley	14 year old-Male Autism	Wednesdays 3pm-11pm Fridays 5pm-11pm	He likes to be out in the community. Male caregiver who can transport preferred by family.
Simi Valley	25 year old-Male Autism/non-ambulatory	Tuesday through Friday 7am-9am	Family prefers a caregiver who is comfortable with lifting and transferring to and from wheelchair.
Oxnard	6 year old-Male Williams Syndrome	Mondays through Wednesdays 5pm-8pm Sundays 4pm-8pm	He likes swinging on his hammock and watching movies. Personal assistance needed; diaper changing. Bilingual (Spanish), MALE caregiver preferred by family. Must be fluent in Spanish.
